

PDS dealer Umesh Kumar Singh and his learned counsel Mr Vijay Anand are absent. BDO, Parsa block is present.

BDO states that the dealer had not appeared before him for the purpose of convergence of the demand.

The statement sent by the DDC, Saran to this Commission shows that when the scheme was closed the dealer was left with 210 quintals of rice. The value thereof was Rs 2,87,727/-. The dealer has not deposited any sum against this demand. Since the dealer has not deposited 50% of the demand, his case is rejected. BDO and the Certificate Officer will proceed to take action in accordance with law. Order for stay of the proceeding granted by the High Court stands exhausted.


