



ORDER

PDS dealer Ramchandra Mahto is represented by his counsel Mr Mukesh Kumar. Mr Abhijit Chaudhary, BDO, Sarai Ranjan block is also present.

The statement sent to this Commission shows that when the scheme was closed the dealer carried a demand of Rs 10,98,740/-. The dealer claims to have deposited Rs 1,25,000/-, Even if the statement of the dealer is taken as correct, he has not deposited 50% of the total demand. Counsel for the dealer states that the dealer will deposit the balance amount to constitute 50% of the demand. Let him do so within one month. It will be open to the dealer to deposit the balance sum in instalments within one month.
