
ORDER

Mr Shanti Pratap has appeared on behalf of PDS dealer Birendra Ram. BDO, Jalalgarh block is absent.

The dealer has deposited Rs 53,915/- which is 50% of the total demand of Rs 1,07,654/-. I have therefore heard Mr Pratap. He says that there was no fault on the part of the dealer in the rice having become rotten. In answer to my question, Mr Pratap says that nothing was given in writing to the BDO or any other officer showing that the rice had become rotten. In that situation I am unable to exempt the dealer from payment of the balance sum. BDO will take suitable action to recover it in accordance with law.

The dealer will be entitled to receive transportation and handling charges @ Rs 13/- per quintal on the total quantity of rice lifted from the BDO, Jalalgarh/DDC, Purnea.

The case is disposed of finally.

In answer to my question, Mr Pratap says that nothing was given in writing to the BDO or any other officer showing that the rice had become rotten. In that situation I am unable to exempt the dealer from payment of the balance sum. BDO will take suitable action to recover it in accordance with law.

The dealer will be entitled to receive transportation and handling charges @ Rs 13/- per quintal on the total quantity of rice lifted ^{by them} from the BDO, Jalalgarh/DDC, Purnea.

The case is disposed of finally.
