Apart from this, BDO has clarified that total dues as stated in the previous report which shows that total 103 quintals of grains were left as residuary with the said dealer, is not correct. After proper enquiry it has been found that out of 103 quintals of grains, only 40 quintals are said to be left with this PDS dealer and rest 63 quintals are with another PDS dealer Parmeshwar Ram who has also deposited Rs 13,000/- but is unwell today.

Let his name be added in the record so that the amount could be realized from both the PDS dealers.
