ORDER

PDS dealer Madhuri Devi and BDO, Mahnar are present.


BDO in his report dated 29/05/17 has stated that Rs 60,000/- has been deposited by the dealer. The dealer has produced a challan dated 12/10/16 of having deposited Rs 62,000/-. The dealer has thus deposited 50% of the total demand of Rs 1,23,300/-. I have therefore heard the dealer on merit.

The dealer states that she should not be made liable to pay the balance sum as the grains deteriorated. It was stated by her that BDO had been told time and again that the grains are liable to deteriorate. It is difficult to accept the oral submission of the dealer. No documentary proof has been produced to substantiate her claim. There was obligation on the dealer to protect and save the grains in her custody. In that view of the matter I am unable to exempt the dealer to pay the balance. Her application is rejected. BDO will take action in accordance with law.

The dealer will be entitled to receive transportation and handling charges @ Rs 13/- per quintal on the total quantity of rice lifted by her.

On interrogation the dealer states that she had lifted 90 quintals of rice and the while thing remained undistributed for want of permits/authorization. This shows the inactivity of the then BDO which is not free from doubt. The Government may proceed to take action against the then BDO as well.

Let this order be communicated to the DDC, Vaishali.
