BDO, Madanpur is present. He has filed a report which contains a list of 21 PDS dealers. Except Sl No.03 Vijay Kumar Singh, all the dealers have deposited the entire amount due against them. Vijay Kumar Singh, PDS dealer is present. He has filed representation with letter no.1729 dated 10/09/11 of the DDC, Aurangabad. Photocopy of order sheet of Sub-divisional Certificate Officer, Madanpur in Certificate Case No.06/11-12 has been filed which shows that the PDS dealer Vijay Kumar Singh had deposited Rs 21,301/- as per demand made by the requisitioning officer i.e. BDO, Madanpur and the case against him was dropped. He again deposited Rs 9,080/-^(980/-) on 24/10/16 in pursuance of the order of DDC, Aurangabad with regard to difference in price.

Let all these papers be kept on record. There is no need to proceed against any dealer of Madanpur Block.
