**ORDER**

In answer to the fresh summons the PDS dealer Binod Mishra appeared. I gave him the opportunity of saying what he had to say. All that he said was that mercy should be shown to him and that he was not in a position to pay any further sum. Since Rs 1,37,000/- is due from him the matter cannot be treated lightly. I have no power to grant any reprieve to any PDS dealer. The dealer was required to keep the grains in good order. I am not prepared to accept that the grains had got rotten. I am firmly of the view that huge quantity of rice had found dubious channels and the dealer profited unjustly by selling them in the black market. The plea therefore for mercy is not acceptable. His plea is rejected. The Certificate Officer shall take steps for realization of the balance sum.

Let this order be communicated to the dealer Binod Mishra as well as the BDO, Banmankhi Block.
