.On 03/02/17 it was recorded in our order sheet that the BDO had directed the dealer in 2010 to sell the rice and deposit the sale proceeds in his office. The dealer accepts that he had sold the rice but he had deposited only Rs 10,641/-. The balance sum has also to be deposited by him. He had been ordered to deposit the balance sum i.e. Rs 10,061/- within one month. He has failed to do so. In that view of the situation his representation is rejected. Certificate proceeding against him may proceed.

PDS dealer Bacha Paswan and the BDO, Bihta are present.

On earlier occasion DDC, Patna had forwarded to this Commission a statement showing, the dealer had lifted 889.80 quintals of rice by 31/12/2005 and 689.97 quintal had been distributed leaving a balance of 168.89 quintals. Today the BDO, Bihta has appeared with a new statement which shows that the dealer had lifted 714.14 quintals of rice. The quantity distributed is shown as 670 quintals leaving a balance of 44.14 quintals. This Commission is at a loss which figure to accept..

I find that the DDC, Patna took no interest in assisting this Commission. DDC has sent one Premanand Jha, a Clerk of his office to explain the situation. He has failed to reconcile the figures. Let the DDC, Patna and the Accounts Officer, DRDA appear with Premanand Jha before this Commission to explain the incongruent situation.
