ORDER

PDS dealer Md Razzaq is represented by his counsel Mr Bimal Kumar. BDO, Amdabad is also present.

Counsel for the dealer has produced photocopy of two drafts each for Rs 47,400/- dated 03/12/16. Apparently, in accordance with the statement of demands sent to this Commission by the DDC dated 30/10/17 the dealer has deposited 50% of the demanded sum of Rs 1,89,550/-. The dealer has deposited the required sum to enable this Commission to hear him. I shall hear the learned counsel for the dealer. He prays for time.


BDO states that he has been delivered a copy of the audit report only yesterday. He also prays for time to examine the audit report.

It is rather surprising that in the earlier statement dated 13/10/17 sent to this Commission the dealer was shown as having been in possession of 138.36 quintals of residual rice. Counsel for the dealer has submitted a copy of the audit report of the auditor Ramakant Jha & Co. which shows that there is only 1.26 quintals of residual rice. It is therefore necessary to examine the auditor also to ascertain process of auditing.

The case is adjourned to 22/11/17. The auditor will also remain present on that date. Let a copy of this order be served on the Programme Officer and the Auditor. DDC will ensure the presence of the Programme Officer and the Auditor.

Mr Bimal Kumar undertakes to serve a copy of his representation on Mr K.K. Mishra, counsel for the State, Mr Binodji Verma, counsel for the Commission and the BDO, Amdabad.
