PDS dealer Ashok Kumar is present alongwith his learned counsel Mr Rabindra Prasad Singh. BDO, Roh Block is also present.

When the scheme was closed the dealer was left with 2312.48 quintals of rice. The value thereof @ Rs 1370/- per quintal would be Rs 31,68,097/-. The dealer has deposited Rs 4,62,496/- up till now. The dealer has still to pay Rs 27,05,602/-. The dealer has deposited only 10% of the demand. It is imperative for the dealer to deposite 50% of the demand for this Commission to hear his case. The dealer agrees to deposit Rs 11,21,553/- to complete 50% of the demand. He must do it by 10/10/17 failng which his case will be rejected. The dealer may file his representation if any in writing by that date.
